1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.316 dated 21.11.2020 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, Sangrur, Punjab.

2. Vide order dated 06.02.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.02.2023 petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gyan Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her further investigation in the present case is not required.

4. In view of the above, interim order dated 06.02.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
