The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 01.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala in a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 titled as Sachin Jain versus Amarjeet bearing NACT/2390/2017 instituted on 27.04.2017.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that vide order dated 17.08.2018, the impugned order was set aside and the petitioner was directed to apply for a bail. Despite the said order having

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been passed, the petitioner did not surrender and has once again been declared a proclaimed offender.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition.

The same stands dismissed.
