1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is endangered at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and his associates.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued by this Court to respondent No.2 to look into matter and take appropriate action, as per law.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Mohinder Singh Joshi, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural) Jalandhar to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and

after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

7. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
