VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondent No.2 to decide the complaint dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has submitted that in the present case, the complaint dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) is not in a correct format and vide letter dated 26.07.2023, respondent No.3 had informed the petitioner about the details which are required to be given in compliance of Regulation 11 of The Punjab Regulation of Fee of Unaided Educational Institution Act, 2016 (as extended to UT, Chandigarh). It is further submitted that in case the petitioner complies with the said regulation and applies according to the

correct format, the respondent authorities would decide the matter as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner would apply in the correct format as prescribed in the relevant regulation and would also comply with the conditions mentioned vide letter dated 26.07.2023 and has prayed that the matter be decided as expeditiously as possible.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with the following observations: -

- (i) Petitioner would make a fresh application after complying with the requirements of the relevant regulation as well as the conditions mentioned in the letter dated 26.07.2023.
- (ii) On doing so, respondent No.2 would decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
