Prayer in this petition is to quash the order dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-4), whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled by learned Special Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib during trial of case FIR No.160, dated 01.09.2021, under Section 22(b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was on bail. He could not appear on 06.07.2023, due to which his bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State. He is ready to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 28.09.2023, the date already fixed thereat.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 28.09.2023, the date already fixed thereat. On his such surrender, the Trial Court shall initiate the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. and after disposal of those proceedings, the petitioner shall be admitted to

bail. Till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having been issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
