1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the consequential benefits and seniority to the petitioner on the post of Municipal Engineer at par, from the date his juniors were promoted to the post of Junior Engineers.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations dated 17.06.2021, 05.10.2021 and 15.12.2021 (Annexures-P-7 to P-9) respectively, submitted by the petitioner, whereupon no action has been taken by the authorities so far, in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.
3. Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide the representations dated 17.06.2021,

05.10.2021 and 15.12.2021 (Annexures-P-7 to P-9) respectively, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
