This is an application for impleadment of the applicants mentioned therein as petitioners No.6 to 9.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Accordingly, the applicants mentioned in the application are impleaded as petitioners No.6 to 9 in the present petition. Amended memo of parties be taken on record and tagged at an appropriate place of the paper book. MAIN CASE

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 10.08.2022 (Annexure P-6) whereby the children from the petitioner home have been ordered to be shifted to another place.

On the asking of the parties, the matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of amicable resolution of the issue.

It has been informed by the counsel for the petitioner No.1 that the settlement has already been arrived at between the parties. Report from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has also been received alongwith the settlement agreement dated 22.09.2023.

Counsel for the petitioners have no objection to the present petition being disposed of in term of the said settlement agreement.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the settlement agreement dated 22.09.2023 received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The parties will, however, remain bound by their respective statements and the terms and conditions of the aforesaid settlement agreement.
