By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the seniority list dated 21.06.2022 (Annexure P-8), office orders dated 27.06.2022, 13.07.2022 (Annexures P-9 and P-10 respectively) as well as Annexure IV attached with the reply dated 24.08.2022 (Annexure P-11), whereby services of respondent Nos.5 and 6 have been regularized w.e.f.29.06.2022. Further the prayer is for a writ of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to regularize the services of the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same in order to approach the department.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
