This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to pass appropriate orders on the application for staying the implementation/operation of the order dated 16.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 till the disposal of the appeal dated 30.12.2021 titled as “Jagat Singh Vs. Harpreet Singh @ Sikandarjeet Kaur” pending in the Court of respondent No.1 filed under Section 16 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1

and 2 as well as learned counsel for respondent No.3 have submitted that the primary grievance of the petitioner in the present case was that the Appellate Tribunal has not been properly constituted and thus, the present writ petition was filed and have further submitted that now, the said Appellate Tribunal has been duly constituted and that the appeal filed by the petitioner is now pending before the Appellate Tribunal for 02.08.2023 and every endeavour would be made by the Appellate Tribunal to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
