The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.90 dated 21.07.2023, registered under Sections 323, 325, 341, 379, 506 and 34 of IPC, at Police Station Kartarpur, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinderjit Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 29.08.2023 is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C subject to the following conditions:-

i) The petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade them to disclose such facts to the Court or to any other authority.

- (ii) The petitioners shall surrender their passports, if any, (if already not surrendered), and in case they are not holder of the same, they shall swear an affidavit to that effect.*
- (iii) The petitioners shall also file their affidavit before the concerned I.O./Arresting Officer, mentioning their ordinary place of residence and number of mobile phone, which shall be used by them during the pendency of the case. In case of change of place of residence/mobile number, they shall share the details with the concerned Investigating Officer.*
- (iv) In case, the petitioners involve in any other criminal activity, during the pendency of the case, it shall be viewed seriously and the prosecution shall be at liberty to move a petition for cancellation of bail granted to them.*
