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The matter has been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that on account of disability, pain and suffering besides transportation and attendant charges, the claimant is entitled to as per his calculation another sum of Rs.5,60,000/-. However, in order to settle the matter, he restricts his claim to Rs.3,50,000/- over & above the amount already awarded by the learned tribunal.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant-Laxman S/o Shri Ram Dhan, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.3,50,000/- favouring the appellant-Laxman S/o Shri Ram Dhan with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.02.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
