ANOOP CHITKARA, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks bail on the ground of long incarceration and he was not named in the FIR. He submits that he is in custody since 28.06.2020. He further submits that the co-accused who was granted bail by this Court, has also beaten by complaint.

State and the complainant opposes the bail. They submitted that the petitioner is an history sheeter and is involved in more than 06 cases and it is not clear that he was in custody in which of these cases.

State as well as counsel for the complainant further submits that the petitioner had fired 06 gun-shots and one of the bullet is still stuck in the spine of the victim. Furthermore, the Police has recovered the firearm along with the live cartridges from the possession of petitioner which corroborated the allegations.

Given the fact that the petitioner is involved in identical cases where he used firearms, he is not entitled to bail on the ground of long incarceration alone. Apart from that one bullet is still stuck in the spine of the aggrieved person and it is not clear that how much time and procedure it will take to remove the same from his spine.

In the given facts and circumstances, the petitioner is fail to make out a case for bail. Petition is dismissed. However, trial Court to expedite the trial and try to complete it on or before 31.05.2023.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that that they would not seek any adjournment.

Petition is dismissed. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of. Trial be expediated.
