The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India claiming that the statutory appeals filed by the petitioner are pending with the Appellate Authority since 09.08.2023 and 16.08.2023 i.e. appeals dated 09.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) and 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) respectively and the authorities are bent upon effecting recovery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset prays for deciding the statutory appeals filed by the petitioner dated 09.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) and 16.08.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-6) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents by filing his *memo of appearance*, and submits that the appeals filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with directions that the statutory appeals dated 09.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) and 16.08.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-6) pending before the Appellate Authority shall be decided within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.

The petition stands disposed of.
