The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing G.D. No.19 dated 29.08.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on 25.09.2021) in case FIR No.101 dated 28.08.2021 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala, Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.09.2022 petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 23.01.2023 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Gurinderbir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala and the same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
