KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and her son by providing adequate security/police protection and also directing respondents No.4 and 5 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. In compliance of the last order, status report has been filed by way of affidavit of Bikramjit Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar(Mohali) after recording the statements of the petitioner as well as of private respondents.

3. The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, submits that in an enquiry by the official respondent, it unfolds that as on date, there is no threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner. However, he further submits that if in future the

petitioner has any threat to her life and liberty, she can approach the authority concerned and the latter shall after examining the apprehension, will take appropriate legal action accordingly.

4. In view of the above statement made by the learned State counsel, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to re-access this Court, in case fresh cause of action arise.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with liberty aforesaid.
