Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that qua the prayer of the petitioner for regularization of his services, the said prayer may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed, at this stage with liberty to agitate the said claim after the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, wherein the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No.17206 of 2014 titled as ***Yogesh Tyagi and another vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 31.05.2018 is pending consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the plea qua the non-grant of equal pay for equal work, which benefit has been given to the similarly situated employees, the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents claiming the same by filing appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the

said representation expeditiously so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner files any representation claiming the benefit of equal pay for equal work, the same be decided in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same be also extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

Petition is disposed of in above terms.
