This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 23.01.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the appeal filed by the petitioners has been dismissed.

On 10.12.2018, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Despite service, none puts in appearance on behalf of respondents 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 24 to 31.

Proceeded against ex parte.

Respondent No.16 is stated to have died.

Counsel for the petitioners to take steps to implead the legal representatives of the said respondent.

Notice issued to respondents 21, 22 and 23 received back unserved for want of correct address.

Fresh correct addresses of these respondents be submitted in the Registry within a period of four weeks.

On doing so, notice be issued to these respondents for 20.03.2019.

Reply to the writ petition be filed by the served respondents within a period of eight weeks.
