AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants states that in case an amount of Rs.2,90,000/- over and above, the amount already paid to the appellants by learned MACT, is paid, this appeal can be settled. Counsel for the appellants has signed the proposal sheet.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 21.08.2023.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. Vinod Khunger, Advocate for the appellants was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.2,90,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Counsel states that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No. 1- Narwinder Singh. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No. 1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Mr. Lalit Garg, Advocate and representatives for respondent No.3-

Insurance Company have also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by the counsel for the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.2,90,000/-(Rupees Two Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only) favouring appellant-Narwinder Singh son of Harchand Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 09.10.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
