The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 3 dated 05.01.2022, under Section 379 and 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Mulepur, Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to following order dated 28.09.2022, passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor is there any evidence in the shape of CCTV footage etc. to connect him with the alleged occurrence and has now been falsely nominated as an accused on the basis of his alleged disclosure statement stated to have been made on 02.08.2022, when he was in custody in connection with another FIR i.e FIR No.82, dated

22.07.2022, Police Station Badali Aala Singh, under Sections 379 and 427 of IPC.”

Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 28.09.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
