On 30.09.2022 the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 16.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by ACJM, Patiala vide which the bail orders of the petitioners were cancelled in case FIRNo.0168 dated 18.10.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala.

The Counsel for the petitioners contend that inadvertently the petitioners were unable to appear on one date i.e. 16.08.2022. The Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to surrender themselves before the trial court within a period of one week from today and on their doing so they shall be admitted to

interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

In compliance of the interim order the petitioner appeared before the Trial Court and was granted the interim bail vide order dated 07.10.2022. Thereafter charges have been framed on 23.03.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that petitioner shall not absent himself from the proceedings in future.
