In the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is that his father, who was diagnosed with cancer, had undergone treatment and the amount spent by the petitioner on the treatment of his father has not been reimbursed fully by the respondents and a direction is being sought to direct the respondent-State to fully reimburse the medical expenses, which the petitioner had incurred on the medical treatment of his father.

The respondent's claim is that the reimbursement is to be done under the Policy as applicable to the Haryana State Government employees and as per the said Policy, in case of an emergency, any treatment which has been taken from an Institute, which is not a recognized or authorized institute, the reimbursement is to be done on the

basis of the amount, which the claimant would have incurred in an authorized hospital. Learned counsel submits that in the present case, the petitioner has already been granted the reimbursement as per his entitlement keeping in view the policy concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not deny the fact that the reimbursement has already been made keeping in view the policy concerned but submits that restrictions imposed in the Policy are bad and the petitioner intends to challenge the same, hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the condition in the policy under which, 100% reimbursement has not been extended to the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.
