The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.4. Further prayer has been made to transfer the enquiry in complaint UID No.2294/146, made by respondent No.5, outside District Ludhiana or to some Senior IPS Officer or independent agency.

In pursuance to issuance of notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Mandeep Singh, P.P.S., Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana, has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, wherein, it has been stated that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from respondent No.4 and the complaints/applications of respondent No.5 have been sent by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to Sh. Suhail Meer, IPS, ADCP-2, Ludhiana, who is not conducting the enquiry on the above-said applications of respondent No.5, against the petitioner and his sons and after completion of enquiry, further appropriate action, if any, will be taken, as per law. It

has been further averred that now, respondent No.4 has no concern or connection with the said enquiry on the applications of respondent No.5, being conducted by ADCP-2, Ludhiana. It has further been averred that in reply to the complaint of son of the petitioner, FIR No.14 dated 25.01.2022, under Section 406, 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station PAU, Ludhiana, has been registered against Gurpreet Kaur, Gurdarshan Singh, Babita Chopra and Vipin Chopra, in which investigation has already been completed and challan/final complaint under Section 173 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has also been presented before the trial Court on 15.11.2022.

In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
