**Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. Vs. Kismati Devi and others**

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The present appeal bearing FAO No.2640 of 2017 has been filed by the appellant-Reliance Gen. Ins. Co. Ltd., against the impugned Award dated 09.01.2017 by MACT, Kurukshetra awarding an amount of Rs.30,61,028/- in favour of the claimants/respondents No.1 to 6, who also filed the cross-objection No.61-CII-2018.

In the appeal filed by the Insurance Company, Rs.5,00,000/- was stayed by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 24.04.2017 and the case has been referred before this Forum for the purpose of settlement. The matter has been settled.

Learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company has made a following statement:-

*“Stated that in the appeal filed by the Insurance Company i.e. FAO No. 2640 of 2017 and XOBJC-61-CII-2018 against the impugned award of Rs.30,61,028/- in favour of the claimants/objectors where in the appeal Rs.5,00,000/- has been stayed by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 24.04.2017. The matter has been settled for an amount of Rs.3,50,000/-(including interest), which is payable to the claimant/appellant No.1-Kishmati Devi, instead of Rs.5,00,000/-(i.e.stayed amount). The appeal be disposed of on the basis of the said settlement”*

Learned counsel for the claimants(respondent No.1 to 6)/cross-objectors has endorsed the said statement/settlement and withdraw the cross-objections.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to pay the amount of Rs. 3,50,000/- (Rs. Three Lakh Fifty thousand only) (including interest) as full and final settlement instead of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh only) in the name of respondent No.1-Kishmati Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or

this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat.

The appeal stands disposed of accordingly. The Cross-Objections are dismissed as withdrawn.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
