1.            The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.102 dated 07.04.2023, registered under Sections 188, 379, 120-B of IPC, Section 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh.
