This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment and decree dated 16.09.2016 passed by learned District Judge, Rupnagar whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the present appellant-husband has been dismissed.

It is to be noted that none appeared on behalf of the appellant on the last date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the respondent on the said date submitted that matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and matrimonial ties have been resumed.
