Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.210 dated 31.7.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioners has *inter alia* contended that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioners and by virtue of previous order, they have joined the investigation with the police and further submits that co-accused Subhash Chand, to whom, main injury is attributed, has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 15.11.2022. Copy of the said order is taken on record.

State counsel on instructions from PSI Ram Chander has admitted that the petitioners joined the investigation and are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation in this

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 30.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
