Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 28.07.2017 (Annexure P-15) whereby the claim of the petitioners for allotment of the land has been declined. Further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to finalize the process of allotment, as earlier as possible as.

Vide order dated 02.11.2023, this Court summoned the DC, Kapurthala. Today, Capt. Karnail Singh, IAS Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala is present in Court. The Court has examined the record and heard the arguments raised by counsel for the parties and has also interacted with the Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala.

Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala has submitted that the case was examined earlier, however, due to paucity of record produced by the petitioners and others, the case could not be decided as per the prayer made by the petitioners. However, he has candidly submitted that if the petitioners submit the requisite record, the same would be re-examined and fresh order would be passed on merits in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he be given some time to produce the requisite record and thereafter, Deputy Commissioner,

Kapurthala be directed to decide the case.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file their requisite application/representation alongwith the relevant record before Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Thereafter, the Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala would re-examine the case and decide the same on merits after hearing the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of filing of the representation/application.

Petitioners would be at liberty to avail their remedy as per law in case any cause of action accrues to them.
