This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 23.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Sirsa-respondent no.2 vide which mutation bearing no.2382 entered and sanctioned in favour of respondent no.3 was ordered to be revised.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed that in view of the observation made in para 27 of the judgment of Hon'ble Division Bench of this court in ***Jagjit Singh vs. Financial Commissioner, Patiala and others***, reported as ***2012(13) RCR (Civil) 96***, he be permitted to withdraw

the present petition with liberty to institute appropriate civil suit challenging the sale deed issued in favour of respondent no.3.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

4. It is made clear that, if any such civil suit is filed, it would be open to all the parties to raise all the pleas as are available to them in law.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
