Instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the action of the respondents whereby the petitioner, who was working as a Tubewell Operator, has been verbally told not to report for duty. Another prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents not to replace the petitioner by another contractual employee.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Perusal of the response filed on behalf of respondents No.6 and 7 shows that the petitioner was involved in a criminal case bearing FIR No. 178 dated 30.03.2017 for offences under Sections 306, 420 and 406 IPC at

Police Station Assandh, District Karnal and he remained in custody from 06.04.2017 to 13.09.2017. He was enlarged on bail vide order dated 13.09.2017 (Annexure R-6/1) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal. These facts have been suppressed from this Court. A person who approaches the Court seeking discretionary relief is required to disclose all the material facts. By hiding his criminal antecedents, petitioner has tried to mislead and hoodwink this Court. This Court has no sympathy with such a person.

Petition is dismissed.
