Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present petition, petitioner No.1 Gurtej Singh, was given pay scale of Rs.60,200/- at the time of his retirement, which benefit was also extended to the other petitioners keeping in view the benefit extended to petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that now, the respondents have decided to withdraw the benefit from Gurtej Singh and consequently, the said benefit is being withdrawn from the other petitioners also but said action is being taken by the respondents without giving any opportunity of hearing by violating the rules of natural justice.

Mr. Tapan Kumar Yadav, learned Deputy Advocate General,

Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from DRO Sirsa and ADA, DC Office Sirsa, very fairly submits as the impugned order dated 04.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) has been passed without giving any opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, the same be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order in accordance with law after giving due opportunity of hearing to the concerned employees.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order has been withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
