The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to release the new Medium Supply (MS) connection to the petitioner-Mill, which has been kept pending by the respondents without any legal and genuine reason.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rangat Joshi, Advocate enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submits that the present petition is not maintainable as there are alternative remedies available to the petitioner not only under the provisions of The Electricity Act, 2003 but also under the provisions of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 for seeking the redressal of his grievance.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the present petition so as to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage with liberty as aforesaid.
