Application has been filed for pre-ponement of the main case from 20.07.2023 on account of the fact that there is a settlement as such and the petitioners wish to withdraw the petition.

Accordingly, the application is allowed.

CM-6198-CWP-2023 has been filed for withdrawal of the main writ petition in view of the settlement arrived at.

Counsel for the respondent-Bank submits that there were three loan accounts and two have been settled and the petitioners are now regularly paying and the third account is also likely to be settled.

Keeping in view the mutual understanding which has been arrived at, we are of the considered opinion that the matter can be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous by binding the bank against the statement.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say, if there is any default, the bank can resort to procedure prescribed under law by issuing appropriate notice to the loanees.
