The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0076 dated 14.09.2022 under Sections 21(1), 4(1) Mines and Mineral Regulation of Development Act, 1957 registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 29.09.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 29.09.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 29.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
