By way of this petition, petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.200, dated 22.05.2017, registered at Police Station Urban Estate Rohtak, District Rohtak, under Section 306/34 of IPC.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Ravinder, DSP, Rohtak on behalf of respondent-State is already placed on record and the same has been perused. As per which, petitioner has already joined the investigation.

It is further pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that whatever amount was invested by the deceased, it was in the account of Sanjit, as per the investigation carried out by the police, petitioner was not found to be the partner of the DPWHO. One of the principal accused Sanjit, in whose account the amount was deposited by the deceased, has already been allowed anticipatory bail by this Court on 11.02.2021. The only role attributed to the petitioner as per police record is that his name is disclosed in the suicide note.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the order dated 29.09.2022, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
