[1] Challenge in the instant petition is to order, Annexure P/6 dated 30.08.2022 passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurugram whereby the application filed by the petitioners in case titled as Smt. Sonu and others vs. Rakesh Kumar and others was partly allowed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurugram and the petitioners were permitted to withdraw the amount of compensation deposited by respondent No.3 subject to furnishing security bonds of equal amount in the Tribunal.
