Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.162 dated 31.8.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

As per report of the mediator, matter has been settled between the parties and the parties executed settlement agreement dated 1.2.2023. Today, counsel for the petitioner has handed over draft of ₹ 2 lakh having No.206038 dated 31.1.2023 and post dated cheque of ₹ 000012 dated 7.3.2023 to the counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant and copies of the same are taken on record.

Counsel for the complainant further submits that the entire settled amount has been received by the complainant and he is having no objection if the present petition is allowed.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh submits that the petitioner who has joined the investigation is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 29.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
