The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing DDR No.27 dated 20.09.2018 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34, 295-A, 148 and 149 IPC in case FIR No.252 dated 20.09.2018 registered under Sections 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Section 295-A and 148, 149 IPC added later on).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 09.01.2023 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Darpan Ahluwalia, IPS, Asstt. Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dera Bassi, Tehsil Derabassi, District SAS Nagar and the same is taken on record. The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gourav Sharma admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
