This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No. 020 dated 29.10.2018 zimini No. 3 on the basis of complaint No. 744-5D/PS Majri dated 01.11.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 364, 511, 506 and 34 IPC in FIR No. 36 dated 28.10.2018 under Sections 307, 342, 452, 353, 186, 427, 148, 149, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Majri Civil District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.11.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation on 11.04.2023 and is no more required for further investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, 597/SAS Nagar submits that in pursuance of the order dated 30.11.2022 passed by this court, the petitioner has since joined the investigation on 11.04.2023 and is not required for any custodial interrogation and further investigation.

4. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 30.11.2022, passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 30.11.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence and influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.
5. The petition stands allowed.
