1. The prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the representation dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner and to take legal action against official respondents No.3 and 4, who are calling her to the Police Station and raiding her house time and again, without any rhyme or reason.

2. Learned counsel submits that vide representation (Annexure P-2), respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala had been duly intimated about the harassment made to the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4. However, the authorities concerned had failed to initiate any action. It has been submitted that the respondent No.2 was under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on her representation.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.
5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala is directed to look into her grievance and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law.
