Instant petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to produce the detenue namely Jasneet Kaur and handover the custody to the mother of the child, the present petitioner.

2. After addressing arguments, at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take all such pleas before the concerned Court where the proceedings under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, (fort short 'the Act') are pending between the petitioner and respondent No. 4 with a prayer that the concerned Court may be asked to dispose of the same in an expeditious manner.
