This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of five marks on the basis of couple case in the Online Transfer Drive, i.e., General Transfers Intra-District (within District), vide letter dated 08.11.2021 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the claim raised in the petition stands satisfied in terms of the new policy, dated 09.08.2023, issued by the respondents. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
