RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Concededly, the petitioner had even earlier approached this Court, but by way of a Public Interest Litigation (CWP-PIL-38-2023), claiming identical reliefs, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 09.08.2023, with liberty to avail such other remedies that were admissible in law:

“Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that she be permitted to withdraw this petition so as to enable the petitioner to avail such other remedies that shall be admissible in law.

**Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as
prayed for.”**

This petition, purportedly, is centered on an individual and personal cause of action, which, upon analysis of the averments set out therein, is not actually so. Thus, the same is not maintainable.

Further, upon being pointedly asked, as to what remedies, the petitioner has invoked/availed qua his concern/grievances, post order dated

09.08.2023 (ibid), counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that he has not initiated any such proceedings.

Faced with this, she prays for and is permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to pursue such other remedies, as indicated in the order dated 09.08.2023, as admissible in law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
