[1]. Through the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in his third attempt in case FIR No.99 dated 21.07.2021 under Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

[2]. The alleged recovery is of commercial quantity.

[3]. Today, during course of the Court proceedings, learned State counsel placed on record the custody certificate issued by the Superintendent of Central Jail, Ludhiana.

[4]. Perusal of the custody certificate reveals that the petitioner is involved in two more NDPS cases, out of which, in one case, he has been convicted and other case is pending for adjudication.

[5]. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, submits that out of total 8 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 7 has already been examined, therefore, the trial is at the fag end.

[6]. Considering the above facts and observations, this Court deem it appropriate not to grant the concession of regular bail. Consequently, this petition is dismissed being bereft of any merit.
