GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today, learned State counsel has informed that the prosecution evidence stands concluded and that as a matter of fact the trial is at the stage of recording of defence evidence and is fixed before the trial Court for 24.04.2023.

In view of the aforestated position, wherein this Court finds that the trial is virtually at its fag end, it would not be appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage in a case of recovery of commercial quantity. The petition, as such, is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to take all necessary steps for expeditious conclusion of trial subject of course to the cooperation extended by the defence counsel as well. In case, there is any inordinate delay in conclusion of trial, it shall be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
