Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.6 to remove encroachment made by it on the land of the petitioner without acquisition in view of legal notice (Annexure P-11), bearing Khasra No.12//21(2-7), 25//1(6-13), 2/1 (2-8), 2/2(5-5), 9(2-0), 10(7-18), 26(0-14) Kitta 7 total land 27 kanal 5 marla situated in village Aariyaimajra, Tehsil and District Patiala by dumping garbage, installation of garbage machine, and fencing of the entire land in an illegal and arbitrary manner. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.6 to pay the compensation to the petitioner for its illegal action of using the land of petitioners by way of encroachment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievances, the petitioners have already filed application dated 13.06.2022 (Annexure P-7) before respondent No.2 but the same has not been decided till date. He further submits that he will be satisfied if

a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State.

At this stage, Mr. Sarthak Soni, Advocate appears for Mr. Sanjeev Soni, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6. He affirmed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala to look into the application dated 13.06.2022 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
