AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 36 days in filing and 4 days in re-filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing and re-filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellant No.1-Balbir Kaur.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) favouring appellant No.1-Balbir Kaur w/o Sh. Jagmail Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 24.04.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the

office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
