Present petition has been filed by petitioner-Gurdeep Singh seeking quashing of order dated 30.4.2010 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in case having FIR No.265 dated 6.10.2008 registered under Sections 307, 326, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court in CRM-M-52744-2022 and thereafter, the petitioner joined proceedings before the Court concerned and finally, the said order of interim bail was made absolute by this Court today i.e. 16.2.2023.

The aforesaid factual matrix is not disputed by the State counsel.

In view of above, as the petitioner has already been granted bail and he has joined the proceedings in the Court concerned and has also furnished requisite bail bonds, the impugned order has become redundant.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the impugned order is hereby set aside.
