1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the private respondents with an additional prayer to direct the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation with regard to the DDR No.28, dated 26.07.2023, registered at Police Station Pojewal, District SBS Nagar and add relevant Sections i.e. 307 & 452 IPC in lieu of the submissions made in the representation dated 02.08.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the scope of the present petition is confined only to the first prayer pertaining to grant of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and he does not wish to press the second prayer since today it has been informed that Section 325 IPC has been added and the petitioner will take the appropriate remedy before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Court below with regard to the aforesaid prayer

and he does not wish to press the second prayer in the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepted notice on behalf of the respondents/State and stated that he has received an advance copy of the present petition and he has also sought instruction from the concerned police official, who is present in Court today. He submitted that so far as the threat perception of the petitioner is concerned, the concerned police officer will certainly look into the threat perception of the petitioner and in case any threat perception and protection is required then appropriate steps shall be taken in this regard in accordance with law.

5. In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsels for the parties, the present petition is disposed of, however with a direction that the aforesaid threat perception shall be ascertained by the concerned police officer within a period of one week from today.
