1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 11 read with Section 2(b) and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 01.06.2023 passed in CRM-M-44741-2021.

2. Short reply dated 12.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Parmila, Inspector, SHO, Police Station Women, Rohtak, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

3. Short replies by way of affidavits of Medha Bhushan, IPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Rohtak; Virender, ASI, posted as Reader to Additional Superintendent of Police, Rohtak; Asha, ASI, Police Station Women Rohtak and Satyawar, ASI, Police Station Women Rohtak, have been filed in the Court today. The same are taken on record.

4. Counsel for the State submits that the order dated 01.06.2023 has since been complied with, and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, then he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
