Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to consider the request-cum-representation dated 01.09.2022 (Annexure P/5) for directing the respondent No.3/Interpol(NCB) to collect the blood samples of the petitioner to prepare her DNA profile.

Submissions on behalf of respondent No.3/Interpol(NCB) have been filed in Court today along with the status report by way of affidavit of

Devender Kapil, Joint Secretary to Government Haryana, Department of Home on behalf of respondent No.4 and the same are taken on record. A copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to the respondents to consider the request of the petitioner directing respondent No.3/Interpol(NCB) to collect the blood samples of the petitioner and to prepare her DNA profile so that the same can be sent to the Republic of Croatia for matching the DNA profile of an unidentified dead body which the petitioner perceives to be of her son.

As per the submissions filed on behalf of respondent No.3/Interpol(NCB), the blood samples of the petitioner had been drawn and her DNA profile had been sent along with a request to the NCB-Zagreb, Croatia on 30.01.2023. The relevant document has been appended along with the response as Annexure 'E'.

In view of the aforesaid, the prayer made in the present petition stands answered and no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

The petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage.
